

Hyperion Compatibility & Support Quick Reference

With the release of **Oracle Hyperion 11.2** just around the corner in Q1 2019, it's time to take a look at some of the biggest compatibility and support issues that you might face.



Microsoft® SQL Server®

MICROSOFT SQL SERVER

SQL Server 2008

No longer supported by Microsoft after July 2019

SQL Server 2012

Not supported by Oracle for Hyperion versions below 11.1.2.4

SQL Server 2014/16

Not supported by Oracle for any Hyperion version (support is expected in Hyperion release 11.2)

Windows Server®

WINDOWS SERVER

Windows Server 2008

Certified by Oracle, but support has expired from Microsoft

Windows Server 2012

Oracle certifies only for Hyperion 11.1.2.4 & won't support older versions

Windows Server 2016

Not yet supported by Oracle for any Hyperion on-premises release (support is expected in Hyperion release 11.2)



INTERNET EXPLORER

Internet Explorer 10

No longer supported by Microsoft since January 2016

Internet Explorer 11

Not supported by Oracle for Hyperion versions below 11.1.2.3.700

Microsoft Edge

Not yet certified for use with Hyperion 11.1.2.4



Attempting to run Hyperion on a platform that Oracle does not certify means that Oracle will not provide support if a bug is encountered.

The future of Hyperion looks bright, but you'll need to get ready well in advance. Start making plans for your Hyperion 11.2 upgrade now.
